NOTICE TO COMPETITORS AND SAILING INSTRUCTION AMENDMENT #1

Notice to Competitors

Following consultation with Farr 40 owners and the Executive Committee, and in the interest of promoting better racing within the fleet, the Farr 40 Class Association has sought and received permission from ISAF to alter RRS 42. Permission has been granted in accordance with RRS 86.2 and this change is being made on an experimental basis for the duration of the New England Championship. Accordingly, RRS 42 is altered as follows:

Amendment to the Sailing Instructions #1

Add the following to Sailing Instruction #1 RULES:

1.6 Alteration to RRS 42:

- (a) Flag [Quebec] displayed at the start line or near a mark, indicates that: "After starting or rounding the nearby mark, RRS 42 is altered in that, except on a beat to windward, pumping the mainsail more than once is permitted."
- (b) Flag [Romeo] displayed near a mark indicates that: "After rounding the nearby mark, RRS 42 applies without alteration."
- (c) At a turning mark or gate, the display of Flag (Quebec) or Flag (Romeo) will be accompanied by numerous sound signals.
